**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
EDEN INTERNATIONAL MINISTRIES, INC.
A NON-PROFIT RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION**

Article I

**The name of the corporation is
EDEN INTERNATIONAL MINISTRIES, INC**

Article II

Article III

The Corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Code and Section 501 (C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Service Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United State Internal Revenue Service Law. The organization is not a private foundation because it is 509 (a) (1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i) -a Church or a Convention or Organization

Article IV

The Corporation shall have members. The eligibility and obligation of the members will be determined by the organization bylaw.

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The method of electing the Board of Director shall be Determined by the Organization bylaws.

Article VIII

Personal liability of all directors (and members) of the Corporation to the Corporation or its members for monetary damages for breach of duty of care or other duty as a director is hereby eliminated to the extent allowed by section the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Code or any successor statute.

Article IX

The Corporation is not organized and shall not operate for pecuniary gain or profit. No part of the property of the Corporation and no part of its net earning shall never be authorized to engage in a regular business of a kind ordinarily carried on for profit or in any other activity except in furtherance of purposes stated above for which the Corporation is organized.

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of attempting to influence legislation, by propaganda or otherwise. The Corporation shall not participate in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Article X

Purpose: The corporation is organized to operate as Charitable, Religious, Worship and Educational, but not limited to teaching, training, writing, printing and publishing, as well as using any and all other means to propagate the Gospel of Jesus Christ and create harmony in the fellowship, under the name and style of "Eden International Ministries, Inc." The organization shall be operated under the direction of a Board of Directors who shall be governed by the Constitution and by-laws of the Corporation and the Gospels as expounded in the Holy Bible, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of that purpose, which are incidental thereto or connected therewith which are consistent with Section 501 (C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Service Code of 1986 or the corresponding

provision of any future United State Internal Revenue Service law. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (C) 3, Internal Revenue Code.

1. Provide "Jesus centered guidance to adult, youth and children on the pulpit, social media and any please that God provide.
2. Create ministries for the spiritual guidance within the Bible Church Doctrine
3. Create community outreach program to educate the most number of person possible with the goal of being a platform or avenue for persons in need of spiritual guidance, feeling of belonging to a religious group, moral value instilment, fellowship and community
4. Educate person and guide them towards a path of salvation as individuals and with their communities.
5. Disseminate the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the Word of God, to the end that people may be evangelized and believers may be conformed to the image of Jesus Christ (Mark 16: 15-16; Isaiah 6: 8 Acts 13: 47; II Corinthians 5: 20) to regularly assemble for fellowship to worship God in Spirit and in truth (Hebrews 10: 25) and to cooperate in the building up of the whole body of Christ (Ephesians 2: 19-22)

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt for Federal Income Tax under section 501 (C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Service Law code of 1986 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law..

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Service Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or applicable code Section Florida Secretary of State, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article XI

The Corporation may reasonably compensate it employees, directors, or officers for services rendered to or for the Corporation in furtherance of one of more of its purposes. The property of the Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to nonprofit religious purposes.

Article XII

The objects and purposes of the Corporation are to acquire and administer funds and property which, after the payment of necessary expenses, shall be devoted exclusively to religious purposes.

Article XIII

The Corporation does not promote, sponsor or agrees with SAME SEX marriages. This rule applies to everyone involved or not involved with the organization. This is based on our faith believes and it is also mentioned on the Holy Scripture (Genesis 2: 24; Mathew 19: 5)

Article XIII

The board of directors of the Corporation shall have the power to admit members to the Corporation in such terms and conditions and with such rights as may be provided from time to time in the bylaws of the Corporation.
