## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF PROYECTO HOPE "PROYECTO ESPERANZA", INC. A NON-PROFIT RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION

#### Article I

### The name of the corporation is PROYECTO HOPE "PROYECTO ESPERANZA", INC.

#### Article II

The mailing address of the initial principal office of the Corporation is 434 Freeman Rd. NW, Palm Bay, FL. 32907

#### Article III

The Corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Code In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., and Section 501 (C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Service Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United State Internal Revenue Service Law. The organization is not a private foundation because it is 509 (a) (1) and 170(b)(1)(A)(i) -a Church or a Convention or a Organization.

#### **Article IV**

The Corporation shall have members. The eligibility and obligation of the members will be determined by the organization bylaw.

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The method of electing the Board of Director shall be Determined by the Organization bylaws.

#### Article VIII

Personal liability of all directors (and members) of the Corporation to the Corporation or its members for monetary damages for breach of duty of care or other duty as a director is hereby eliminated to the extent allowed by section the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Code or any successor statute.

#### **Article IX**

The Corporation is not organized and shall not operate for pecuniary gain or profit. No part of the property of the Corporation and no part of its net earning shall never be authorized to engage in a regular business of a kind ordinarily carried on for profit or in any other activity except in furtherance of purposes stated above for which the Corporation is organized.

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of attempting to influence legislation, by propaganda or otherwise. The Corporation shall not participate in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

#### Article X

The Corporation is organized Pursuant to the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Code In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S.. The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is to establish and oversee places of worships, impact lives throughout the love and the gospel of Jesus Christ, teach and preach the gospel to all people, conduct evangelistic and humanitarian outreach, engage in activities which are necessary, suitable or convenient for the accomplishment of that purpose, which are incidental thereto or connected therewith which are consistent with Section 501 (C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Service Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United State Internal

Revenue Service law. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (C) 3, Internal Revenue Code.

#### The Corporation is organized:

- a) To provide assistance in teaching so as to train people to read, write, begin tutorial program, mentorship program and to have training in the skills of life, including but not limited preparing them to complete a general education.
- b) Provide "Jesus centered guidance to adult, youth and children on the pulpit, social media and any place that God provide.
- c) To send forth home and foreign missionaries to the spreading and extending the Gospel of God though out the world (Mark 16:15-16, Act 13:47,4:29-30).
- d) To establish and maintain a place where ministry and their families may go to spend together in a Christian atmosphere conducive to the strengthening of Christian family values and family activities local and overseas.
- e) To provide and foster continuing education for the orphan child local and overseas. To establish a center where community member may come for recreational, dietary and nutritional counseling and where children may play a safe environment. To provide program to improve the dignity of people residing in areas devastated by poverty, drug and alcohol.
- f) To disseminate the Gospel of Jesus Christ and the Word of God, to the end that people may be evangelized and believers may be conformed to the image of Jesus Christ (Mark 16: 15-16; Isaiah 6: 8 Acts 13: 47; II Corinthians 5: 20) to regularly assemble for fellowship to worship God in Spirit and in truth (Hebrews 10: 25) and to cooperate in the building up of the whole body of Christ (Ephesians 2: 19-22)
- g) To create ministries for the spiritual guidance within the Bible Church Doctrine

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt for Federal Income Tax under section 501 (C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Service Law code of 1986 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law..

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (C) 3 of the Internal Revenue Service Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or applicable code Section Florida Secretary of State, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
