ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
In compliance with Chapter 617, F. S., (Not for Profit)

Articles of Incorporation of the undersigned, who are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of Florida, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be Don Manley Writing Ministry, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the "corporation".

ARTICLE II

The initial street address of the principal office of this corporation in the State of Florida is: 12493 CR 103, Oxford, FL 34484. The Board of Directors may from time to time move the principal office to any other address in Florida.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal

Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VII

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

The registered agent for service of process within this state shall be Donald R. Manley of 12493 CR 103, Oxford, FL 34484.




