Article VII

On the dissolution of the corporation, the board of directors, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, distribute all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for charitable, scientific or educational purposes in such a manner and to such qualified organization or organizations as the board of directors shall determine. Any of the assets not so distributed shall be distributed in accordance with any court having jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for the above purposes of the corporation or to a qualified organization or organizations as the court shall determine. For the purposed of this article, an organization is a "qualified organization" only if, at the time of receiving the assets, it is operated exclusively for the purposes described in 26 U.S.C.A. Section 170(c)(1) or 26 U.S.C.A. Section 170(c)(2)(B) and is described in 26 U.S.C.A. Section 509(a)(1), (2), or (3).
