Request for Reinstatement of Corporate Status

To Whom It May Concern:

It is our request that the Division will review the following circumstances and reinstates the above referenced corporations without penalty and have a reinstatement date of October 16, 1998. This request is based on facts involving a change in leadership, an injury to the executive director, and apparently the check and annual reports never being received by the Division for the last reporting period. These circumstances resulted in the administrative dissolution due to the Division not receiving the check and annual reports.

On August 14, 1998, a check was issued and the annual reports were completed for these corporations. That afternoon they were mailed to the Department of State to complete the filing requirements. The check was never cashed and it was not realized that this was the check that was sent to the Division of Corporations for the annual reports until this year. That was when it was brought to the attention of the president by one of the members when they stumbled upon the internet site and discovered the administrative dissolution had occurred.



In addition, during the year of 1998, our organization changed from a fiscal year to a calendar year reporting cycle. This was due to the national organization making the change and they made the appropriate decision to realign themselves with national. This resulted in the corporation having elections in April, 1998, and again in December, 1998. The caused some confusion and the organization is still resolving other issues due to the short term. This transition resulted in the late filing of the original check and in the end; the check and annual reports did not arrive in Tallahassee.

Furthermore, the executive director and registered agent, Daniel E. Maxson, was injured in a serious automobile accident during November, 1997, and had to be replaced temporarily as the executive director. However, he was finally replaced due to the magnitude of his injuries. This change resulted in a number of questions and concerns on meeting filing deadlines, proper reporting requirements, remitting monthly payments, and lost information. This was a major impact to the organization and was another factor in the late filing of the original check and annual reports.

We believe that these circumstances will provide the substantiation for the Division to abate the penalties and reinstate the corporations as of October 16, 1998. Please consider our request and make a favorable decision. We have enclosed a check for \$490.00, that covers the \$61.25, for each corporation, for the filing years of 1998 and 1999, along with the reinstatement forms for each corporation in view of a favorable decision.

Please contact our office as soon as possible for any additional information or to discuss this situation further.
