# Florida Nonprofit Articles of Incorporation

#### **FOR**

### Allen's Home of Hope, Inc.

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a Florida not-for-profit corporation, hereby Adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

#### Article I Name

The name of the corporation shall be: Allen's Home of Hope, Inc.

Article II Principal Office

## Article III Purpose

To provide former Women inmates of Florida a safe Transitional housing alternative, to teach a multitude of skills to empower the women to self-sufficiency, and facilitate the possible reunification of clients with their children.

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes: Christian missions, humanitarian activities including but not limited to disaster recovery and relief aid programs, and educational and related instructive or learning programs.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and

distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be disturbed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
