
A. This Corporation is a non-profit Public Benefit Corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Non-Profit public Benefit Corporation laws for.

The specific purpose of this corporation is to provide provides a comprehensive resource to assist and produce professionals in orthotic and prosthetic medical treatment of veterans, civilians, and children to improve their quality of life by regaining independency. In addition to providing healthcare, our goal is to promote entrepreneurship and O&P career opportunities to inner city youth to achieve diversity within the medical field.
