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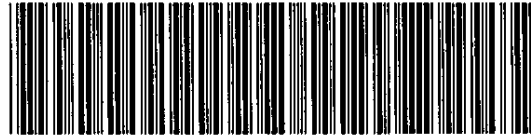

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
LIGHTHOUSE GLOBAL FELLOWSHIP, INC.**

The undersigned citizens of the United States, desiring to form a not for profit corporation under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, certify and acknowledge the following:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the Corporation Not for Profit shall be Lighthouse Global Fellowship, Inc. ("Corporation").

ARTICLE III: PURPOSE

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code and herein stated as follows:

The corporation is organized as a religious organization that works to provide education, food, shelter, and counseling to the low-income and homeless in the Duval County, Florida, and surrounding area(s). The purpose of this corporation shall include but not be limited to the following: establish and teach the beliefs in the Scriptures of the Old and the New Testament as God's inspired Word, and to provide a vehicle and institution for the preaching and teaching of the belief and faith in God. To implement and to incorporate programs to provide assistance to poverty-stricken, homeless, fatherless and/or motherless families. To provide programs for high risk youths, teenage education on pregnancy/parenting, and drug use. To provide rehabilitate services for juvenile and adult law offenders. To encourage a healthy community through community programs and services.



ARTICLE VIII: EFFECTIVE DATE

ARTICLE IX: AMENDMENTS

Any amendments to the Articles of Incorporation may be adopted as set forth in the bylaws.

ARTICLE X: INDEMNIFICATION

The corporation does indemnify any directors, officers, employees, incorporators, and members of the corporation from any liability regarding the corporation and the affairs of the corporation, unless the person fraudulently and intentionally violated the law and/or maliciously conducted acts to damage and/or defraud the corporation, or as otherwise provided under applicable statute.

ARTICLE XI: DISTRIBUTIONS UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the legal liabilities of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
