ARTICLE 1

The name of the corporation is Mentee 2 Mentor Youth Ambassador and Sports Program Inc.

ARTICLE 2 PURPOSE OF CORPORATION

Said organization is exclusively for charitable, mentorship, educational and athletic purposes. Combating community deterioration and juvenile delinquency, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE 2 ROHIBITIONS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article second hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the Mentee 2 Mentor Youth Ambassador and Sports Inc. shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (A) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (B) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 1 70(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE 3 DIRECTORS

The directors shall be elected by a majority vote of the board members of this corporation.

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ARTICLE 4 TERM OF EXISTENCE

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE 5 CAPITAL STOCK

This corporation shall have no capital stock and shall be composed of members rather than stockholders.

ARTICLE 6 QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP

The categories of membership, qualifications for membership and the manner of admission shall be as set forth in and regulated by the Mentee 2 Mentor Youth Ambassador and Sports Program Inc. the corporation.

ARTICLE 7 VOTING RIGHTS

Members of the corporation will have such voting rights as are provided in the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE 8 LIABILITIES FOR DEBTS

Neither the members nor the members of the board of directors or officers of Mentee 2 Mentor Youth Ambassador and Sports Inc. shall be liable for the debts of the corporation.

ARTICLE 12 AMENDMENT

These articles of incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law. Every amendment shall be approved by the board of directors, proposed by them to the voting members, and approved at a members meeting by a majority of the members, unless all the directors and all the members sign a written statement manifesting their intention that a certain amendment of these articles of incorporation be made.

ARTICLE 13 INDEMNIFICATION

The corporation shall indemnify a director or officer of the corporation who was wholly successful, on the merits or otherwise, in the defense of any proceeding to which the director or officer was a party because the director or officer was a party because the director or officer is or was a director of officer of the corporation against reasonable attorney fees and expenses incurred by the director or officer in connection with the proceeding.

All references in these articles of incorporation are deemed to include any amendment or successor thereto. Nothing contained in these articles of incorporation shall limit or preclude the exercise of any right relating to indemnification or advance of attorney fees and expenses to any person who is or was a director, officer, employee, or agent of the corporation or the ability of the corporation otherwise to indemnify or advance expenses to any such person by contract or in any other manner. If any word, clause or sentence of the foregoing provisions regarding indemnification or advancement of the attorney fees or expenses shall be held invalid as contrary to law or public policy, it shall be severable and the provisions remaining shall not be otherwise affected. All references in these Articles of Incorporation to "director", "officer" "employee", and "agent" shall include the heirs, estates, administrators, executors, and personal representatives of such persons.

ARTICLE 14 COVENANT NOT TO SUE

The corporation agrees that it will never institute any action or suit at law or in equity against any director or officer of the corporation, nor institute, prosecute, or in any way aid in the institution or prosecution of any claim, demand, action, or cause of action for damages, costs, loss of services, expenses, or compensation for or on account of any damage, loss or injury to person or property, or both, whether developed or undeveloped, resulting or to result, known or unknown, past, present, or future, arising out of a director or officer of the corporation's service to the corporation

ARTICLE 15 DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal

government, or so disposed of shall be disposed of by court of competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal officer of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
