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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE BRAELEN FOUNDATION, INC.

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SECULE OF OF STALE

The undersigned, acting as incorporator, of a corporation under the Florida Corporations Not For Profit Act, hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is The Braelen Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual and shall become effective upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

This corporation is being organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) and for any lawful purpose as permitted by the Florida Corporations Not For Profit Act. The specific purpose of The Braelen Foundation includes, without limitation to provide financial, physical, emotional and spiritual assistance to the survivors of homicide victims (including those related to the victim through blood, marriage or mutual association); to support the communities in which they live through professional development assistance; and to support communities at large through recognition for projects, humanitarian ethos, publications, teaching and individual achievements.

ARTICLE IV PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The address of the initial principal office of business of the Corporation is 313 Harts Oak Place, Seffner, Florida 33584.

ARTICLE V DISTRUBTUON OF EARNINGS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) (or the corresponding provision of any future Federal tax code) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to

which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) (or the corresponding provision of any future Federal tax code.)

ARTICLE VI CORPORATE DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3), or the corresponding provision of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VII OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

The method and election of directors shall be prescribed by the Bylaws of the Corporation. The initial officers and directors of this corporation shall be:
