ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF TROPIC ISLES ELEMENTARY PTO. INC.

THE UNDERSINGNED, Yecksenia Greene, being a natural person and competent to contract, wishing to form a corporation not for profit, does hereby submit the following Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation not for profit under the laws of the state of Florida.

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be **TROPIC ISLES ELEMENTARY PTO**. and it is located at 5145 Orange Grove Boulevard, North Fort Myers, Florida 33903, the address herein for mailing annual reports shall be 5145 Orange Grove Boulevard, North Fort Myers, Florida, 33903.

ARTICLE II

This corporation is organized and dedicated to operating a Parent-Teacher Organization at TROPIC ISLES ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS in North Fort Myers, Florida.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes including: (A) To own and hold, buy and sell, lease and transfer real and personal property, all of which shall be solely for charitable and educational purposes. (B) To solicit and accept gifts for money or property in order to carry out the purposes hereinabove set forth; and (C) To do any and all things necessary and desirable for the achievement of any of the objects and purposes of this organization.

Anything herein in the Article II to the contrary notwithstanding, the purpose for which the Corporation is organized is exclusively, charitable, literary, and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE III

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or to disputable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in article II hereof. No substantial part of the activity of the Corporation shall be used for the purpose of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of the Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (A) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (B) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(C)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.)

ARTICLE IV

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence. Provided, however, that in the event the Corporation shall at any time be dissolved, in such event, the assets of the Corporation after making provision for payments of all liabilities of the Corporation, shall be distributed to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), federal government, or a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of by a Court of general jurisdiction in Lee County, Florida, and distributed exclusively for the above charitable or educational purposes hereinabove mention.

ARTICLE V

The qualification of members shall be those persons who express an interest in helping further the purpose of the Corporation described in Article II hereof.

ARTICLE VIII

The Affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by the following officers: The President; the Vice President; the Secretary and the treasurer.
