ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR THE DALE MABRY ARMY AIR FIELD MUSEUM, INC A NONPROFIT FLORIDA CORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of the Not for Profit Corporation Act of this state, the undersigned incorporator hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I Name

The name of this corporation is Dale Mabry Army Air Field Museum, Inc., a Nonprofit Florida Corporation.

ARTICLE II Principal Place of Business

The principal place of business and mailing address for the transaction of business for the Dale Mabry Army Air Field Museum, Inc. will be in Leon County, Florida at the location of 3676 Corinth Drive, Tallahassee, Florida 32308.

ARTICLE III

The Dale Mabry Army Air Field Museum, Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are to study, and if feasible, establish a museum, open to the general public, that preserves and shares the history, artifacts and other memorabilia related to the Dale Mabry Army Air Field, and its indelible socio-economic and cultural influences on Tallahassee and the Big Bend Region through exhibits, lectures, curricula and other appropriate means of preservation and dissemination.

ARTICLE IV Manner of Election

Board members and officers shall be elected according to the bylaws.

ARTICLE VI Limitations on Private Inurement

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes described in section 501(c)(3). No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VII Dedication of Assets

Upon the dissolution of this organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
