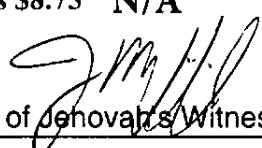

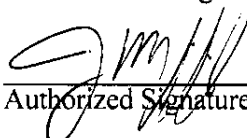

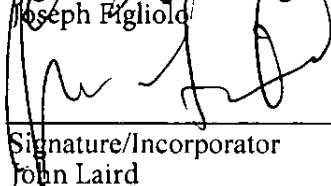

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CHARTER

OF

SOUTH UNIT OF JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES OF VERO BEACH, FLORIDA, INC.

We, the undersigned, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a non-profit corporation under the LAWS OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, by and under the provisions of the Statutes of the State of Florida providing for the formation, rights, privileges and immunities of corporations not for profit, said statutes being set forth as Chapter 617 of The Laws of a General Nature under arrangements of the Florida Statutes of 1941.

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be SOUTH UNIT OF JEHOVAH'S WITNESSES OF VERO BEACH, FLORIDA, INC., with the principal place of business in the City of Vero Beach, Florida.

ARTICLE II

The general nature and object of the incorporation shall be: the moral and mental improvement of men and women; the dissemination of Bible truths in various languages by means of the radio and distribution of tracts, pamphlets, papers and other documents explaining the Bible prophecy concerning the establishment of Jehovah's Kingdom under Christ Jesus; in harmony with and under the direction of the governing body of Jehovah's Witnesses in the United States; and by the use of all other lawful means which its Board of Directors shall deem expedient for the purpose stated; and for Christian missionary work, charitable, benevolent, scientific, historical, literary and Christian or religious purposes. The business of the corporation shall be conducted by a president, vice-president, and secretary-treasurer. In the event of a vacancy a successor shall be appointed by a board of directors. The board of directors shall be the governing body of the corporation. The board of directors shall consist of five members provided that the number of directors may be increased or decreased by a vote of the members cast as the by-laws may direct; provided, however, that the number of directors shall not be less than three nor more than nine.
