**Articles of Incorporation
For
DIVERSITY ARTS, INC.**

Pursuant to the provisions of §617, Florida Statutes, this *Florida Not For Profit Corporation* adopts the following as its Articles of Incorporation:

**ARTICLE I
NAME**

The name of the corporation shall be: DIVERSITY ARTS, INC.

**ARTICLE II
PRINCIPAL OFFICE**

**ARTICLE III
PURPOSE**

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is exclusively for charitable purposes, including, for such purposes as making of distributions to organization that qualify as exempt organization under Internal Revenue Service Code Section 501(c)(3), or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The charitable organization shall promote the arts by serving disenfranchised youth and other groups by providing safe environments, guidance, education, and materials for self-discovery, self-expression, and cultural interaction as it relates to the creation and promotion of art in different forms.

**ARTICLE IV
ELECTION OF DIRECTORS**

The manner in which the directors are elected and appointed shall be by majority vote held not less than once per year, or as otherwise expressed in the corporate by-laws.


These articles shall become effective upon the date of filing.

Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
