### STATE OF FLORIDA ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

#### MELVIN R. CLAYMAN CHARITABLE FOUNDATION INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617. Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

#### ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be MELVIN R. CLAYMAN CHARITABLE FOUNDATION INC..

# ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS/MAILING ADDRESS

The principal place of business of the corporation is 6553 NW 39th Terrace, Boca Raton, FL 33496. The mailing address of the corporation is P.O. Box 810186, Boca Raton, FL 33481.

## ARTICLE III PURPOSE(S)

The purpose for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, religious and educational within the meaning of the Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set for in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any further federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any further federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose as set forth in the minutes of the corporation. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

## ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTOR(S)

The method of election of directors is so stated in the bylaws of the corporation. The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is three (3), until their successor(s) are elected and shall qualify.
