ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

Section 1.01 The name of the corporation shall be: Global Vision Edu Corp.

ARTICLE II DURATION

Section 2.01 Duration

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III PRINCIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE IV PURPOSE

Section 4.01 Purpose

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is: This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

This corporation prepares children in impoverished and disadvantaged communities to contribute to their region and beyond by engaging in the development of the community through education, religious outreach, resource infrastructure, and proper healthcare, with an application of knowledge acquired.

The specific objectives of this organization shall be: To provide an educational foundation and financial support for schools in disadvantaged regions; To provide facilities, equipment, and a trained staff for education, resources, healthcare, and missionary outreach; To provide opportunities for children and other members of disadvantaged communities to engage in their communities' development.

To maximize our impact on current efforts, we may seek to collaborate with other non-profit organizations which fall under the 501(c)(3) section of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, and are operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes.

At times, per the discretion of the Board of Directors, we may provide internships or volunteer opportunities which will provide opportunities for involvement in said objectives in order to have a greater impact for change.

Section 4.02 Public Benefit

Global Vision Edu Corp. is designated as a public benefit corporation.

ARTICLE V NON-PROFIT NATURE

Section 5.01 Non-Profit Nature

Global Vision Edu Corp. is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501.(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No part of the net earnings of Global Vision Edu Corp. shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by any organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501. (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by any organization contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Global Vision Edu Corp. is not organized and shall not be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its educational and charitable purposes. No part of the assets, receipts, or net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to any individual. The corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

Section 5.02 Personal Liability

No officer or director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of Global Vision Edu Corp. of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property or assets of the officers or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

Section 5.03 Dissolution

Upon termination or dissolution of the Global Vision Edu Corp., any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one (1) or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, which have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, included a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

The organization to receive the assets of the Global Vision Edu Corp. hereunder shall be selected by the discretion of a majority of the managing body of the Global Vision Edu Corp. and if its members cannot so agree, then the recipient organization shall be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in a court of proper jurisdiction against the Global Vision Edu Corp. by one (1) or more of its managing body which verified petition upon a finding that this section is applicable shall select the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference if practicable to organizations located with the State of Florida.

In the event that the court shall find that this section is applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose, which, at least generally, included a purpose similar to the corporation, then the court shall direct the distribution of its assets lawfully available for distribution to the Treasurer of the State of Florida to be added to the general fund.

Section 5.04 Prohibited Distributions

No part of the net earnings, or properties of this corporation, on dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or any other private person or individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III, Section 3.01.

Section 5.05 Restricted Activities

No substantial part of the corporation's activities shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Section 5.06 Prohibited Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision of the Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax as an organization described by Section 501.(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (2) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170.(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VI BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 6.01 Governance

Global Vision Edu Corp. shall be governed by its board of Directors

Section 6.02 Manner of Elections

The manner in which the directors are elected and appointed: Directors shall be elected by a majority vote of the Board of Directors then in office.
