Articles of Incorporation of

Inspire Youths Mentoring Services, Inc.

(Document Number of Corporation)

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, this *Florida Not For Profit Corporation* adopts the following amendment(s) to its Articles of Incorporation:

Article III purpose, be and it hereby is, amended as follows:

The Corporation will make no distributions of Income to its Directors, unless it is dissolved pursuant to Florida Law. The specific purposes for which this corporation is formed include, but are not limited to the following:

- 3.1. Inspire Youths Mentoring Services, Inc. has a special commitment to provide social and emotional services in a group based setting serving at risk youths, i.e., ones who have had or have juvenile delinquencies, drug addiction or educational issues and defaults.
- 3.2. Organizing and promoting participation in the learning experience and providing support services to enhance the educational opportunities of the community's at risk youths in achieving the necessary education and social development to improve their employment opportunities.
- 3.3. To exercise all powers and discharge all responsibilities granted to it as a corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, its By-Laws, and these Articles of Incorporation.
- 3.4. To otherwise engage in any lawful activities for the benefit, use, fulfillment of its goals, the goals of its participants and those of the community.
- 3.5. Said Organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 3.6. Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 50l(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposed or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

The foregoing Amendment was adopted on July 2, 2018.

There are no members or members entitled to vote on the amendment(s). The amendment was adopted by the Board of Directors.
