



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S. (Not for Profit) 17 SEP 18 編刊D: 3日



ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: Companions For Courage, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

Principal street address: 400 W. Woodward Avenue, Eustis, FL 32726

Principal mailing address: 400 W. Woodward Avenue, Eustis, FL 32726

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

- 1. The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The corporation is to provide an exclusive group of therapy animals in accordance with s. 92.55, F.S. to be available to assist, including but not limited to, children and adult victims of violent offenses, in the courtroom, at depositions and counseling sessions, and during any other traumatic situations. The therapy animals will help to relax the victim, serve as company to the victim when not present in the courtroom, accompany the victim to the witness stand and be present by the victim's side during their testimony.
- 2. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.
- 3. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
