ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CONSULTA POPULAR CUBANA INC. A FLORIDA CORPORATION NOT FOR PROFIT

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this Corporation will be CONSULTA POPULAR CUBANA INC., hereinafter designated "CPC."

ARTICLE II NATURE

CPC is organized as a Florida corporation not for profit, intended to be entitled to non-profit status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding provisions of subsequent federal tax laws exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, as established and when consistent with Article III below. It is also expressly provided that, notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets will be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or will be distributed to the federal government, or to a state of local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of will be disposed of by the Circuit Court the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court will determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE III PURPOSES

The general nature, objects and purposes of CPC will be to (a) develop and implement social research projects, which contribute to the exercise of the Cuban people's right to determine their political future, as a sovereign manifestation of their individual will through the free exercise of the vote, in a framework of constitutional democratic evolution and continuing reform of the current legal system, promoting the separation of powers, contributing, promoting and guaranteeing respect for human rights and fundamental freedoms in keeping with international law, as guaranteed by the Universal Declaration of Human Rights; (b) promote, organize and participate in legal forums, which encourage and propitiate debate and the exchange of ideas about ideal principles for Cuba's future legal system, its judiciary and other civil institutions and the operational dynamics of civil society actors, to weave the indispensable net to implement and support the Rule of Law in Cuba; and (c) implement legal courses and educational activities and outreach programs, to improve the legal culture and the understanding of the free legal institutions in the island.

ARTICLE IV GENERAL POWERS

General powers of CPC will be all powers incident to promoting its objectives.

ARTICLE V MEMBERS

Whether civil, criminal, administrative, or investigative, other than one by or in the right of CPC to procure a judgement in its favor, brought to impose a liability or penalty on such person for an act alleged to have been committed by such person in his capacity as director, officer, employee or agent of any other corporation, partnership, joint venture; trust or other enterprise which he/she fines, amounts paid in settlement and reasonable expenses, including attorneys' fees, actually and necessarily incurred as a result of such action, suit or proceeding or any appeal therein, if such person acted in good faith in the reasonable interest of CPC, such action was in the best interest of the reasonable ground for belief that such action was unlawful. The termination of any such action, suit or proceeding by

- By or in the right of CPC to procure a judgement in this favor by reason of his being or having been a director or officer of CPC, or by reason of his being or having been a director, officer, employee or agent of any other corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise which he/she served at the request of CPC, against the reasonable expenses, including attorneys' fees, actually and necessarily incurred by him in connection with the defense or settlement of such action, or in connection with the defense or settlement of such action, or in connection with an appeal therein if such person acted in good faith in the reasonable belief that such action was in the best interest of CPC. - b. Interested directors may be counted in determining the presence of a quorum at a meeting of the Board or of a committee which authorized the contract or transaction.
- c. No part of the net earnings of CPC will inure to the benefit of any Member, Director or Officer of CPC or any private individual. Provided, however, that (i) reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered by any Member, Director or Officer to or for CPC, and (ii) this provision will not prohibit the reimbursement of funds advanced to, for or on behalf of CPC by any Member, Director or Officer when said funds are advanced with the consent and knowledge of CPC, evidenced by the written approval of the majority of the Board, including, without limitation, transportation and other travel expenses.

ARTICLE XIV DISSOLUTION OF CPC

- a. Upon dissolution of CPC, all of its assets, remaining after provision for creditors and payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution, will be distributed to other non-profit corporation(s) devoted to similar goals.
- b. CPC may be dissolved upon a resolution to that effect being recommended by three-forth (3/4) of the members of the Board, and, if such decree be necessary at the time of dissolution, after receipt of an appropriate decree as set forth in Florida Statutes Section 617.05 or statute of similar import, and approved by two-thirds (2/3) of the voting rights of CPC's members.
