Why should they get laptops oppose to going to the library?

- It is beneficial for their education. A lot of kids that come into care are very behind academically and having a laptop in the comfort of the home where they can work at their own pace will be more accepting. Rather than them going to the library and feeling pressured because their on a time crunch then that will result in them getting flustered which then ruins the whole experience making them have no interest in doing homework what's so ever.
- Because it is not time consuming. Group homes usually have more than two children in their homes. The thought of having to pack up all the kids, take them to the library, have them all sign in and then wait for a computer to use is a lot on any caregiver. With the laptops at the home the children can be monitored better and actually stay focus on the homework they need to complete.
- The laptops can be used as therapy for special needs children. From my personal experience with working with autistic children they respond well to soothing music and living in a group home can be a little loud and chaotic at times and children with special needs do not respond well in that type of environment but with the laptop it can keep them calm and more manageable.
- It can be used as a teaching purpose. For example how to take care of things if they go to the library they are not going to care about the public computers but if it's their own laptop they would treat it with a lot more respect.
