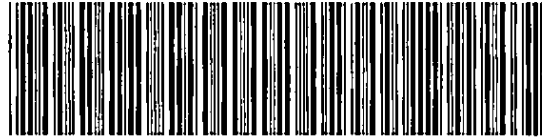

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes (Not for Profit)

The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States of America, desiring to form a Non-Profit Corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Florida, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I NAME

The primary purpose of the corporation is to support the students, parents, and instructors of the DeSoto County High School women's basketball program by recruiting volunteers, raising and distributing funds, and offering any logistical support needed. The secondary purpose of the corporation is to support the students, parents, and instructors of other women's sports at DeSoto County High School by recruiting volunteers, raising and distributing funds, and offering any logistical support needed. The corporation is organized and will be operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. All references to sections in these Articles refer to the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 as amended or to comparable sections of subsequent internal revenue codes.

ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes (Not for Profit)

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.


Upon dissolution of the corporation, its assets shall be disposed of exclusively for the purposes of the corporation or distributed to such organizations organized and operated under Section 501(c)(3), or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

ARTICLE IX EFFECTIVE DATE

The effective date of this corporation shall be the date the Florida Division of Corporations receives and files these Articles of Incorporation.


