ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

Article I – Name of the Corporation

The name of the corporation shall be: From Inc. to Inc. Entresition Services Inc.

Article II – Principle Office

Article III - Purpose

The organization is residential housing outreach program for *ex-offenders* as well as those on work release. The organization shall operate exclusively for religious, charitable, educational and other purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (hereinafter "Code"). As a means of accomplishing the foregoing purposes, the corporation shall have the power to engage in any lawful act or activity necessary or appropriate to the attainment of those purposes; provided, however, that notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Bylaws, or any other provision of law, the corporation shall not have the power to carry on any activities which would cause it to fail to qualify, or to fail to continue to qualify, as (i) an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Code, or (ii) an organization to which contributions are deductible under sections 170, 2055 and 2522 of the Code.


Article VIII - Other Provisions

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
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
