ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

Silvertone Singing Convention Incorporated. (SSCI) is a non-profit entity that will address many of the needs of at-risk youth with ages ranging from 9 to 21. We will provide both educational and support services to our target population by way of teaching, mentoring, coaching and tutoring through music and dance education. These services will be offered year round.

Our community outreach program serves individuals of limited means throughout the greater Miami and Fort Lauderdale, Florida area. Each year Silvertone Singing Convention reaches beyond its studio doors and offers free dance classes, performances, and educational opportunities creating a community rich in positive growth and change. Silvertone Singing Convention is spreading the word of God through the arts to people that are wounded afflicted, oppressed and are hurting through life situations.

We introduce dance and music to troubled teenagers as a positive alternative to drugs, alcohol and violence. We teach Youth and Adults to be in the HIS presence through music and dance for singing and dancing before the Lord is a humbling experience; one totally abandons himself to the act of expressing his love and joy to the Lord. It is intimate and personal, and it is not expressed for the of the observer. Our goal is to go the lost and to bring the good news of the Gospel that the Son of God has risen and HE has come to release the captives.

We evangelize through the arts making an impact through dance and drama that cannot be erased. We mentor and train vessels to go out and minister as well as train leaders in local churches. They are taught the word of God where dance and music takes place in the Body of Christ, how to minister, how to dress in ministering, and living and conducting themselves as vessels of God. The process is done by preparing them exams that they will take in the training program as well as in the classroom. They will have both written and practical exams.

Our vision is to spread the word of god through the arts nationally, globally and to raise up leaders to make in the creative arts. Our vision is to see millions of souls get saved, delivered and set free through dance, song and dramatized word through the performing arts. We desire to minister music and dance in such a way as to bring others INTO HIS PRESENCE (the presence of God). We desire to present our body as a living sacrifice-ministering in dance to others as the Lord Ministers to us.

We will also provide scholarship for youth based on the merit or needs-based scholarships. Free summer dance training and job skills programs for Miami and Fort Lauderdale teens.

The activities and services of Silvertone Singing Convention, Inc. are available to all residents of the communities in which it serves without regard for income, race, color, national origin or handicap of the participants.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501C(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III thereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Not withstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501C (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170C (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501C(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
