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Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation of

PALM CITY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (U.S.A.), INC.

A Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation

WHEREAS, PALM CITY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (U.S.A.), INC., a Florida notfor-profit corporation (the "Corporation") has been granted gracious separation from The Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.); and

WHEREAS, the Corporation wishes to amend and restate its Articles of Incorporation to reflect the new name of the Corporation and to reflect that the Corporation is now affiliated with the Evangelical Covenant Order of Presbyterians; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 617.1001, 617.1006 and 617.1007 of the Florida Statutes, the Corporation, certifies that:

1. The Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation set forth herein were duly recommended by unanimous written consent of the Board of Elders dated June 10, 2012.

2. The Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation set forth herein were approved by the Members of the Corporation on June 10, 2012, and the number of votes cast were sufficient for approval.

3. The duly adopted Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation supersede the original Articles of Incorporation and all amendments to them.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 617.1007 of the Florida Statutes, the Articles of Incorporation of PALM CITY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH (U.S.A.), Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation, are hereby amended and restated as follows:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the Corporation is PALM CITY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, INC. (hereinafter referred to as the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II. PURPOSES AND POWERS

The purposes for which the Corporation exists and its powers are as follows:

A. To receive, hold, encumber, manage and transfer property and to facilitate the management of its civil affairs in such a manner as may be directed by its Session from time to time.

B. To take, receive, hold, administer and dispose of all lands, tenements, rents, annuities, franchises, hereditaments, moneys, securities, income and property, real and personal, of any kind, which at any time or times heretofore have been or which at any time and from time to time hereafter be given, granted, bargained, sold, released, devised, bequeathed, conveyed, transferred, assigned, set over or delivered by any person or persons, corporations, associations, trustees, foundations or other forms of organization, to this Corporation or to its predecessors, or to its use, or in trust for it, or to it for the support of any work, activity, purpose, project or interest of the Corporation or its predecessors, in which property of any kind the Corporation or its predecessors has or is intended to have any legal or equitable interest, present or future, vested or contingent.

C. To take over, administer, manage and supervise all civil affairs of the Corporation, subject to the direction and authority of the Session of the Church.

D. To form, incorporate, terminate or dissolve civil agencies or corporations to carry out any of its purposes, which actions shall be reported to the Session of the Church; and to manage, supervise, control, direct and maintain such civil agencies or corporation.

E. To exercise all the powers conferred by law upon corporations not for profit, to the extent that such powers are not in conflict with the purposes of the Corporation nor with the directions or policy of the Evangelical Covenant Order of Presbyterians.

F. To operate exclusively for such religious purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Code.

G. This Corporation will not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code or (b) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code are composed or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code are composed on the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code are composed on the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code are composed on the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or any other corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

ARTICLE III. DISSOLUTION

If the Corporation is formally dissolved, or becomes extinct by reason of the dispersal of its members, the abandonment of its work, or other cause, such property as the Corporation may have, both real and personal, shall be distributed to a tax exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.

ARTICLE IV. TERM

The term of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V. MEMBERS

The Members of the Corporation shall be the active members of the Church, PALM CITY PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH, INC. Qualification, admission, termination, standing and all other terms and conditions of membership shall be the same as those for active membership in churches organized as a part of the Evangelical Covenant Order of Presbyterians. The Members shall not be personally liable for the debts of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI. TRUSTEES

The management of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Trustees of not less than three Trustees, each of whom must be a Member of the Corporation in good standing. The Members shall elect the Trustees in accordance with the By-Laws of the Corporation. The Trustees shall deal with the property of the Corporation only as they may be authorized or directed by the Session of the Church. The Trustees shall exercise their authority in conformity with the actions of the Session as conveyed to them from time to time. The Trustees shall not be personally liable for the debts of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII. OFFICERS

The officers of the Corporation shall be a President, a Vice President, a Secretary and a Treasurer, and such other officers as may be elected by the Trustees from time to time. Two or more offices may be held by the same person, except that the same person may not be President and Secretary simultaneously. The officers shall be elected and committees may be established by the Board of Trustees in accordance with the By-Laws of the Corporation. These Articles of Incorporation may be amended at any annual meeting or special meeting by a two-thirds vote of the Members present, provided that a full reading of the proposed changes (or a printed distribution of the same) shall have been made in connection with the call of the meeting.
