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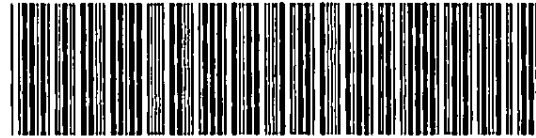

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

The undersigned incorporator for forming a Florida not-for-profit Corporation, hereby adopts the following articles of incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the not-for-profit Corporation is

The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

The not-for-profit Corporation aims to research production and promotion to the Hispanic Community of theater and performing arts. Such as theater plays and musicals, dance, music, visual arts, literature and other emerging cultural expressions as well as promoting education and multiculturalism as well as community development of education through the arts. The organization is established exclusively for the advancement of art education, providing low-cost or free programs to the underprivileged youth in the Miami and other areas.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the not-for-profit organization, assets shall be distributed to the federal Government for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future code, or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed by a Court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
