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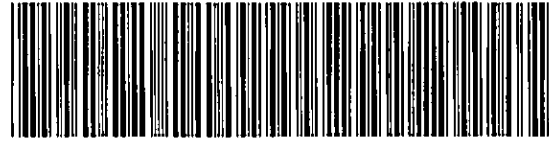

**Articles of Incorporation of
GameFace 4:13 Training Academy, Inc.**

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

The undersigned incorporators, pursuant to the nonprofit corporation laws of this state, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

Article I. Name

Article V. Purpose

The purpose of this corporation is to provide youth development programming during after-school and non-school day hours. The specific objectives and purpose of this organization shall be:

- a. to provide inner-city youth opportunities to engage in recreational and competitive sports through instruction in sports and by providing equipment and facilities for participation in sports
- b. to provide character development through faith-based principles
- c. to provide youth development through life skills and career skills programming
- d. to sponsor, host and/or participate in events and activities that promote sports
- e. to provide educational services through academic programming and tutoring

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

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Article VI. Manner of Election

There shall be at least three (3) directors. The directors will be elected, maintained, and appointed in accordance with the Bylaws of this corporation.

Article X. Additional Provisions

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article XI. Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article XII. Effective Date

The effective date of incorporation shall be: February 1, 2018

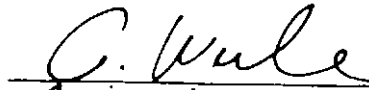
