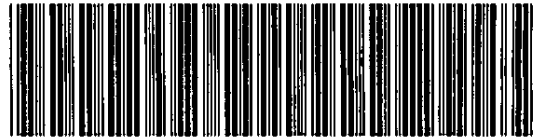


Amendments Adopted
