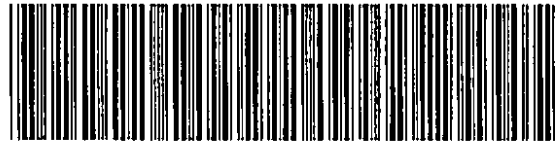

**Article 1.**

The name of the corporation is Blossom Together Academy and ABA Services, Inc.

**Article 2.**

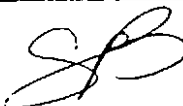
