

THE UNDERSIGNED, each with the capacity to contract, hereby submits, executes and acknowledges these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation in compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit).

ARTICLE 1. NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be SELEAVEYA DILLARD MINISTRIES, INC.

ARTICLE 2. ADDRESS

The location of this Corporation's Principal Office is 11100 NW 23RD COURT, CORAL SPRINGS, FL 33065

ARTICLE 3. PURPOSE

Said organization is organized, exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE 4. MANNER OF ELECTION

Election of Board members shall occur at each annual meeting of the Board of Directors. The terms of directors shall be staggered. Initial Board members shall serve staggered terms of [one and two years, or one, two, and three years]. Thereafter, Board members shall serve two-year terms with approximately one-third of the Directors elected at each annual meeting. ARTICLE 8. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors shall manage the activities and affairs of the Corporation. ARTICLE 9. MEETING

Meeting of members may be held outside of the State of Florida, if the Bylaws so provide. The books of the Corporation may be kept (subject to any provisions contained in the statues) outside of the State of Florida at such places as may be from time to time designated by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE 10. BYLAWS

The first Bylaws of the Corporation shall be adopted by the Board of Directors and may be amended, altered or rescinded by the Board of Directors in the manner provided by such Bylaws.

ARTICLE 11. NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

This corporation is a non-profit corporation. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to it members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 4. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by a Corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under

Section 170 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 of the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Laws.

ARTICLE 12. DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE 13. AMENDMENTS

The Corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provisions contained in this certificate of incorporation, in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by the statute, and all rights conferred upon members herein are granted subject to their reservations.

Having been named as registered agent to accept service of process for the above stated corporation at the place designated in this certificate, I am familiar with and accept the appointment as registered agent and agree to act in this capacity.
