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

ATTACHMENT

- A. The primary objective of the Corporation is to see sinners delivered from the ravages of sin and to give their lives to Jesus Christ. As a result of the Corporation's existence, the Gospel of Jesus Christ as found in the King James Version of the Holy Bible will be preached and taught. The people of God will become strengthen and matured in the word of God and made whole.
- B. This will occur by the anointed preaching of the word of God in services, revivals, crusades and other modes of delivery on TV, radio and internet. The preaching of the gospel will result in a multitude of people being delivered from spiritual, emotional and physical infirmities.
- C. The Corporation will facilitate and expand the outreach ministry to multitudes of people who will profit from his ministry via media ministry, written materials, revivals, conventions, speaking engagements, seminars and workshops.
- D. The Corporation is organized and operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or to any corresponding provision of any future federal tax law, including (a) Charitable and educational services, (b) educational development, (c) economic empowerment, (d) crime prevention, (e) family development, and (f) financial literacy. The Corporation is to be funded by charitable donations, grants and sponsors.
- E. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any trustee, director, or officer of the Corporation, or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation and reimbursement for business expenses), and no trustee, director or officer shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets upon dissolution of the Corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Code), or participating in, or intervening in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office."§§
- F. Notwithstanding any other provision hereof, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code), or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code)."§§
- G. Upon the termination, dissolution or final liquidation of the Corporation in any manner and for any reason, the Board of Directors shall first pay or provide for the payment of all liabilities of the Corporation; all remaining assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code (or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code), or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to state or local government, for a public purpose.
