

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF NAPLES-ON-THE-GULF KIWANIS CHARITABLE FOUNDATION INC.

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S. (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is: Naples-on-the-Gulf Kiwanis Charitable Foundation Inc.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business is: 3871 Ist Avenue SW, Naples, FL 37117

The mailing address of the corporation is: 3871 1st Avenue SW, Naples, FL 37117515

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

This Corporation is organized pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Not-for-Profit Corporation Act. The organization provides assistance to local charities benefiting children and community needs. It may also engage in other charitable functions as may be permitted under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so

disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE IV - MANNER OF ELECTION

The method of election of the Directors shall be set forth in the By-Laws.
