**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
VETERAN EVALUATIONS OF FLORIDA, INC.**

ARTICLE I - Name

The name of the corporation is Veteran Evaluations of Florida, Inc.

ARTICLE II - Address

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the Corporation is

ARTICLE III - Purpose

The Corporation is formed under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes and shall operate exclusively for charitable, scientific and educational purposes pursuant to section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE IV - Directors

The directors of the Corporation will be appointed as specified in the bylaws.

ARTICLE V - Incorporator

The name and address of the incorporator is Michael L. Smith, 1101 Douglas Avenue, Altamonte Springs, Florida 32714.

ARTICLE VI - No Private Inurement

A. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III.

B. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VII - Assets upon dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE VIII-Officer

The initial officer of the Corporation is Richard C. Turner.

ARTICLE IX - Effective Date

The Corporation shall be effective upon the filing of the Articles of Incorporation.


