ARTICLE III Purposes

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IX Prohibitions

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Second hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from federal income tac under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, of the corresponding section of any future deferral tax code.

ARTICLE X Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the Corporation in accordance with Florida law, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of the remaining assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation and in accordance with the requirements for exemption under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The assets may be distributed by the Board of Directors to any organization or organizations which qualify for exemption under 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding provision of the future United States Internal Revenue Law. Any assets not disposed of as provided above shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of Broward County, Florida or any other court having jurisdiction over the Corporation in regard to its dissolution exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation.
