ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CHARLES AND MELANIE WINTON FOUNDATION, INC.

(A Corporation Not-For-Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME AND ADDRESS

The name of the corporation is CHARLES AND MELANIE WINTON FOUNDATION, INC. (the "Corporation"). The principal office or mailing address of the Corporation is 4501 Old Course Drive, Charlotte, North Carolina 28277.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law (the "Code") and is not formed for up pecuniary profit or financial gain. The Corporation is authorized to perform any lawful-act or activity for which corporations not-for-profit may be formed under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles to the contrary, the Corporation shall not have or exercise any power which would cause it not to qualify as a taxexempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code; nor shall the Corporation engage directly or indirectly in any activity which would cause the loss of such qualification.

ARTICLE III **MEMBERS**

The members of the Corporation shall consist of the individuals constituting the Board of Directors herein provided, and their successors in office. The qualification for membership in the Corporation may be modified as provided in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE IV **DIRECTORS**

The number of directors constituting the Board of Directors of the Corporation shall be as provided in the bylaws of the Corporation (the "Bylaws"), provided, however, the number of directors shall not be less than three (3). The manner in which the Directors are to be elected or appointed shall be as stated in the Bylaws. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial Directors until the first annual meeting of the Corporation or until their successors are elected are:

ARTICLE V PROPERTY

The members of the Corporation shall have no vested right, interest or privilege of, in, or to the assets, functions, affairs, or contracts of the Corporation, nor shall the members have any such right, privilege, or interest which may be transferable, or inheritable, or which shall continue when membership ceases. Title to all property of the Corporation shall be held in the name of the Corporation or as otherwise may be provided pursuant to the authority of the Bylaws of the Corporation. Any gift, bequest, devise or donation of any kind whatsoever to the Corporation or its Board of Directors shall be deemed to vest title in the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI REGISTERED AGENT

ARTICLE VII AMENDMENTS

These Articles may be amended as provided in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VIII DISTRIBUTION UPON DISSOLUTION

Upon the liquidation or dissolution of the Corporation, its assets, if any, remaining after payment (or provision for payment) of all liabilities of the Corporation, shall be distributed to one or more organizations qualified as exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

ARTICLE X TAX EXEMPT RESTRICTIONS

Prohibition on Private Inurement. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the contrary, no part of the net earnings, current or accumulated, or property of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, any member (other than a member which is exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code), director, officer, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services actually rendered and to make payment and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

- Prohibition on Dividends. Notwithstanding any other provision Section 2. of these Articles to the contrary, the Corporation shall not have the power to declare dividends.
- Limitation on Lobbying Activities. Notwithstanding any other Section 3. provision of these Articles to the contrary, no substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.
- Prohibition on Intervening in Political Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles to the contrary, the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- Tax-Exempt Status. Notwithstanding any other provision of Section 5. these Articles to the contrary, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Sections 170(c)(2), 2055(a)(2), and 2522(a)(2) of the Code.

ARTICLE XI INDEMNIFICATION

The Corporation shall indemnify any officer, director or employee, or any former officer, director or former employee, to the fullest extent permitted by law.
