ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SURFERS FOR AUTISM II, INC.

These articles of incorporation of a Florida not-for-profit corporation are being adopted pursuant to the *Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.*

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is SURFERS FOR AUTISM II, INC.

ARTICLE II

ARTICLE III

The specific purpose for which the corporation was organized is as follows:

The corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in section 501(c)(3) of the *Internal Revenue Code*, or any corresponding section of any future federal tax code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. This corporation shall be a nonprofit organization. The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is to hold fundraisers to benefit Autism Research and Awareness and to create events that introduce children with autism to the sport of surfing.

ARTICLE VIII

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its member(s), trustee(s), officer(s) or other private person(s), except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purpose of the corporation, nor shall be corporation carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the *Internal Revenue Code*, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the *Internal Revenue Code*, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IX

Upon the dissolution, termination or winding up of the affairs of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purpose(s) within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the *Internal Revenue Code*, or any corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations which are organized and operated exclusive for such purposes as said court shall determine.

Having been named as registered agent and to accept service of process for the above stated corporation at the place designated in this certificate, I am familiar with and accept the appointment as registered agent and agree to act in this capacity.
