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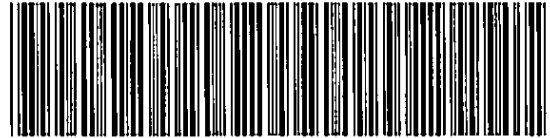

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
AL AMIN CENTER I OF FLORIDA, INC.

We, the undersigned, with other persons being desirous of forming a *not-for-profit* corporation, under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, do agree to the following:

ARTICLE I – Name & Address

The name of the corporation shall be:

AL AMIN CENTER I OF FLORIDA, INC.

The principal office and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

8101 South Military Trail

ARTICLE II - Purpose

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, literary and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, and more specifically, the Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively to carry out the following purposes:

- (a) To own and operate an elementary, middle and secondary educational institution serving Palm Beach County and surrounding areas in accordance with state and local laws.
- (b) To accept, hold, administer, invest and disburse for scientific, educational and charitable purposes such funds or property as may from time to time be given to it by any person, persons, or corporations, or earned by it in its activities;
- (c) To provide children with a wholesome and safe environment where academic excellence and moral character can be achieved.

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ARTICLE III - Dissolution

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding Sections of any prior or future Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State or local government for exclusive public purpose.

Article IV – Bylaws

The Bylaws of the Corporation are to be made, altered or rescinded by members in good standing.

Article V – Personal Liability

No member, officer, or director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of this corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the members, officers, or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

**ARTICLE VI – Board of
Directors & Officers**

Management of the Corporation shall be vested in the Corporation's Board of Directors, the members of which shall not be less than five and no more than nine. The method of election of corporate directors is as stated in the bylaws. No director or officer shall have any rights, title, or interest in or to any property of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII – Limitations

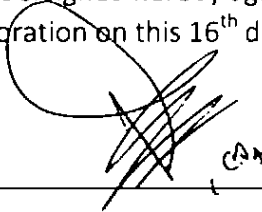
No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof.

The Corporation shall have the power to acquire, own, maintain and use its assets for the purposes for which it is organized; to raise funds by any legal means for the encouragement of its purposes; to acquire, hold, own, use and dispose of real or personal property in connection with the purposes of the Corporation; to exercise all powers necessary or convenient to the furtherance of the purposes for which the Corporation is organized: and to exercise all powers granted to a corporation *not-for-profit* under Florida law. In addition to the powers specified, the Corporation shall have the additional powers as specified in its bylaws, in furtherance of the purposes set forth in ARTICLE II hereof.

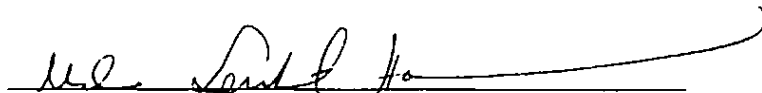
