### Article VI

#### CONFLICT OF INTEREST POLICY

#### 1.1 Purpose

The standard behavior at the Bright Lights Crossing Borders, Inc. organization is that all staff, volunteers, and board members scrupulously avoid conflicts of interest between the interests of the Bright Lights Crossing Borders, Inc. organization on one hand, and personal, professional, and business interests on the other. This includes avoiding personal and actual conflicts of interest, as well as perceptions of conflicts of interest.

I understand that the purpose of this policy is to protect the integrity of the Bright Lights Crossing Borders, Inc. organization's decision-making process, to enable our communities and public to have confidence in our integrity, and to protect the integrity and reputations of volunteers, staff, and board members. Upon or before election, hiring, or appointments, I will make a full, written disclosure of interests, relationships, and holdings that could potentially result in a conflict of interest. This written disclosure will be kept on file and I will update it as appropriate.

#### 1.2 Duty to Disclose

About an actual or possible conflict of interest, an interested person must disclose existence of the financial interests and be given the opportunity to disclose all material facts to the directors and members of committees with governing board delegated powers considering the proposed transactions or arrangement

#### 1.3 Determining Whether a Conflict of Interest Exists

After disclosure, I understand that I will be asked to leave the room for discussion and will not be permitted to vote on the question. I understand that this policy is meant to supplement good judgement, and I will respect its spirit as well as its wording.

#### 1.4 Violations of the Conflict of Interest Policy

- a) If the governing board or committee has reasonable cause to believe a member has failed to disclose actual or possible conflicts of interest, it shall inform the member of the basis for such belief and afford the member an opportunity to explain the alleged failure to disclose.
- b) If, after hearing the member's response and after making further investigation as warranted by the circumstances, the governing board or committee determines the member has failed to disclose an actual or possible conflict of interest, it shall take appropriate disciplinary and corrective action.

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## Article VII

#### Dissolution

Upon termination of dissolution of the Bright Lights Crossing Borders, Inc., any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one (1) or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1983 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statue) which organization or organizations have charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

The organization to receive the assets of the Bright Lights Crossing Borders, Inc. hereunder shall be selected by the discretion of majority of the managing body of the Bright Lights Crossing Borders, Inc. and if its members cannot so agree, then the recipient organization shall be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in a court of proper jurisdiction against the Bright Lights Crossing Borders, Inc. by one (1) or more of its managing body which verified petition shall contain such statements as reasonably indicate the applicability of this section. The court upon a finding that this section is applicable shall select the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference if practicable to organizations located within the State of Florida.

If the court shall find that this section is applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose, which, at least generally includes a purpose similar to this corporation, then the court shall direct the distribution of its assets lawfully available for distribution to the Treasurer of the State of Florida to be added to the general fund.
