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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF UNBROKEN HORIZONS SCHOLARSHIP FOUNDATION, INC. a Florida not-for-profit corporation

ARTICLE I <u>Name</u>

The name of the Corporation is Unbroken Horizons Scholarship Foundation, Inc. (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II Principal Office

The principal office and mailing address of the Corporation is 11683 Donato Drive, Jacksonville, FL 32226.

ARTICLE III Purposes and Powers

- 3.1 The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes as contemplated by Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, specifically to raise funds to provide college scholarships to students attending post-secondary schools in the United States, who demonstrate appropriate need and merit, and related non-profit purposes qualifying as tax-exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act.
- 3.2 No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this Article.
- 3.3 Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this Corporation.
- 3.4 No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- 3.5 Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or (ii) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

3.6 Subject to the foregoing provisions of this Article III, the Corporation shall have all the powers conferred upon a corporation under the provisions of the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and any enlargement of such powers conferred by subsequent legislative acts, and shall have all powers necessary, proper, convenient, or desirable in order to fulfill and further the purposes of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IV Board of Directors

- 4.1 <u>Number</u>. The powers of the Corporation shall be vested in the Board of Directors. The number of directors may be increased or decreased pursuant to the Bylaws of the Corporation, but shall never be less than one (1). The directors shall be elected pursuant to such procedures as are specified in the Bylaws.
