In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

Article I Name

The name of the corporation shall be: The Hope Center of Baker County, Inc.

Article II Principal Office

Article III Purpose

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Providing assistance, education and support to those addicted and their families, having readily available treatment options and support to help prevent overdose and death.

Article IV Manner of Election

Article VI Limitations

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article VII Dedication of Assets

Upon the termination of The Hope Center of Baker County, Inc., any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one (1) or more qualifying corporations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute) which organization or organizations have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

The organization to receive the assets of The Hope Center, Inc. hereunder shall be selected by the discretion of a majority of the managing body of The Hope Center of Baker County, Inc. and if its member cannot so agree, then the recipient corporation shall be selected pursuant to a verified Petition in equity filed in a court of proper jurisdiction against The Hope Center, Inc. by one (1) or more of its managing body which verified petition shall contain such statements as reasonably indicate the applicability of this section. The court upon a finding that this section is applicable shall select the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference if practical to organizations located within the State of Florida

In the event the court shall find that this section is applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose, which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to this corporation, then the court shall direct the distribution of its assets lawfully available for distribution to the treasury of the State of Florida to be added to the general fund.

No part of the net earnings, or properties of this corporation, on dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private person or individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered

to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set for in Article III, Section 3.01
