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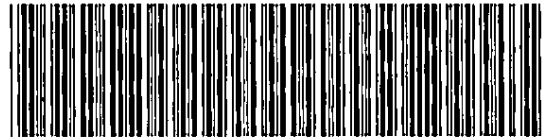

The undersigned incorporator is an individual 18 years of age or older and adopt the following articles of incorporation to form a nonprofit corporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME OF NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION

The name of this corporation shall be Journey of Youth Development Inc.

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL AND MAILING ADDRESS OF ORGANIZATION

The location in Florida where the principal office of the Corporation is to be located is in the City of Jacksonville, Duval County at 9480 Princeton Square Blvd S Apt. 2203.

ARTICLE III - ORGANIZATION'S PURPOSE

The corporation is organized exclusively for educational, religious, and charitable purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The specific purpose of the corporation is to educate and encourage students by helping them achieve academic excellence. The corporation's purpose is to reach students who are below grade level and assist them with earning grade level or above grade level status. The corporation will primarily offer this opportunity to low income families and public/charter schools.

ARTICLE IV - ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

At all times the following shall operate as conditions restricting the operations and activities of the corporation:

1. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be

authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof.

2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code

ARTICLE V - INITIAL OFFICERS AND/OR DIRECTORS

ARTICLE VI - PERSONAL LIABILITY

No member, officer or director of this corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of this corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the members, officers or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

ARTICLE VII - DURATION/ DISSOLUTION

The corporation will have a perpetual existence, unless dissolved by the officers, directors or shareholders, or by operation of law.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
