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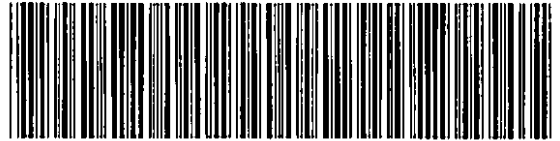



## **AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR PLUS LIFE MAS VIDA, INC.**

The undersigned incorporator, for the purpose of forming a Florida non-for-profit corporation,  
hereby adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

### **Article I**

The name of the corporation is:

Existence  
The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

### **Article IV**

Members  
The corporation will not have members

### **Article V**

Indemnification  
The corporation does indemnify any directors, officers, employees, incorporators, and members of the corporation from any liability regarding the corporation and the affairs of the corporation, unless the person fraudulently and intentionally violated the law and/or maliciously conducted acts to damage and/or defraud the corporation, or as otherwise provided under applicable statute.

## Article VI

The specific purpose for which this corporation is organized is:

The purpose of the corporation is exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the internal revenue code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code and herein stated as follows:

Plus Life Mas Vida focus on improving the quality of life for kids, teenagers and adults around the world with lack of resources to access potable water, food and basic education, providing an option for them to be active in society and succeed in life.

Plus Life Mas Vida through the support of volunteers and donors will be driving local initiatives through local communities and churches around the world.

### Initiatives:

**WATER:** By Supporting local communities to embrace water projects that can provide potable water for them to drink, cook and develop their daily activities minimizing the impact of get access to potable water.

**FOOD:** By providing food and supplies to local organizations (rural schools, churches, nuns, orphans) to facilitate the cooking and meals for kids and families that do not have resources to get food every day.

**EDUCATION:** By providing school supplies, uniforms, and in some cases supporting teachers access. Supporting local initiatives that drive kids to get access to education.

## Article VII

### Prohibited Activities

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 11. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

## Article VIII

### Distributions Upon Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the legal liabilities of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.





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
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
