Nonprofit Corporation Articles of Incorporation

Pursuant to §617 of the Laws of Florida, the undersigned majority of whom are citizens of the United States, do hereby submit these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of establishing a nonprofit corporation.

ARTICLE 1

Name

1.1.1. The name of the corporation shall be: Cash for Cops Fund, Inc.

ARTICLE II Principal Office

2.1 The principal office of the corporation shall be: 6739 Adams Street, New Port Richey, FL 34652.

ARTICLE III

Purpose

- 3.1 The purpose for which the corporation is organized is: to raise monetary funds for active New Port Richey, Florida police officers and provide funds to these officers in emergency situations.
- 3.2 The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV Manner of Election

4.1 The manner in which directors are elected or appointed is provided in the bylaws of the corporation.

ARTICLE V Existence

5.1 The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

9.1 No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof.

- 9.2 No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing and distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- 9.3 Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE X **Dedication of Assets**

10.1 Upon the dissolution, termination, or winding up of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
