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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ISLAND STORAGE SUITES CONDOMINIUM OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE I NAME OF CORPORATION AND PRINCIPAL ADDRESS

The name of this corporation shall be Island Storage Suites Condominium Owners Association, Inc., hereinafter referred to as Association. The principal office of said corporation shall be located at 5424 Shearwater Drive, Sanibel, Florida 33957. The Directors of the Association may change the location of the principal office of said Association from time to time.

ARTICLE II PURPOSES

The purposes of this Association shall be the operation and management of the affairs and property of the condominium known as Island Storage Suites, a Commercial Condominium, located in Lee County, Florida, and to perform all acts provided in the Declaration of Condominium Ownership and the Florida Condominium Act, Chapter 718, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE III POWERS

The Association shall have all of the statutory powers of a corporation not for profit and all of the powers and duties set forth in the Florida Condominium Act and the Declaration of Condominium Ownership, as amended from time to time, except as may be limited or otherwise provided by these Articles.

ARTICLE IV MEMBERS

All record owners of legal title to any of the condominium units of the Condominium shall be Members of the Association. Membership shall terminate automatically and immediately as a Member's interest in the record legal title terminates, except that upon termination of the entire condominium project, the membership shall consist of those who were Members at the time of each conveyance of the respective units to the Association, or its designee, as provided in said Declaration of Condominium Ownership.

After the Association approves of a conveyance of a condominium unit as provided in the Declaration of Condominium Ownership, the change of membership in the Association shall be evidenced in the Association records by delivery to the Secretary of a copy of the deed or other instrument of conveyance.

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ARTICLE V VOTING RIGHTS

Each condominium unit shall be entitled to one vote based upon the condominium units percentage interest in the Common Elements at Association meetings, notwithstanding that the same owner may own more than one unit or that units may be joined together and occupied by one owner.

ARTICLE VI INCOME DISTRIBUTION

No part of the net earnings, if any, of the Association shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any private shareholder, director, officer or other private person; provided, however, that the Association shall be authorized and empowered to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof; and provided, further, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to prevent the payment of fees, salaries or other remunerations to the Directors, officers or other persons, firms or corporations.

ARTICLE VII REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The registered office of the Association shall be 5424 Shearwater Drive, Sanibel, Florida 33957. The registered agent of the Association will be John W. Hilbert II, 17056 Marina Cove Lane, Fort Myers, Florida 33908. The Board of Directors may change the registered agent and office from time to time as permitted by law.

ARTICLE VIII EXISTENCE

The term for which this Association is to exist shall be perpetual, unless dissolved according to law. If the Association is dissolved, the control or right of access to the property containing the surface water management system facilities shall be conveyed or dedicated to an appropriate governmental unit or public utility and that if not accepted, then the surface water management system facilities shall be conveyed to a non-profit corporation similar to the Association.

ARTICLE IX SUBSCRIBER

The name and residence of the subscriber to these Articles is John W. Hilbert II, 17056 Marina Cove Lane, Fort Myers, Florida 33908.

ARTICLE X DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

- (A) The affairs of the Association will be administered by a Board of Directors consisting of the number of Directors determined by the Bylaws, but not less than three (3) Directors, and in the absence of such determination shall consist of three (3) Directors. The initial Directors consisting of persons named by the Developer to the Board need not be Members of the Association. All non-developer Directors shall be Members of the Association, or spouses of Members.
- (B) Except for persons appointed by the Developer to the Board of Directors, all Directors of the Association shall be elected by the Members in the manner determined by the Bylaws. Directors may be removed and vacancies on the Board of Directors shall be filled in the manner provided by the Bylaws.
- (C) The business of the Association shall be conducted by the officers designated in the Bylaws. The officers shall be elected each year by the Board of Directors at its first meeting after the annual meeting of the Members of the Association, and they shall serve at the pleasure of the Board.
- (D) The names and addresses of the Members of the first Board of Directors, and the officers, who shall hold office until their successors are elected and have qualified, or until removed, are as follows:

ARTICLE XI BYLAWS

The Bylaws of this corporation may be amended, altered or rescinded in the manner provided in such Bylaws.

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ARTICLE XII AMENDMENTS

The Association reserves the right to amend, alter, change or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation by a simple majority vote of all voting rights of all Members of the Association. Amendments to these Articles shall be proposed and adopted in the following manner:

- (A) Notice of the subject matter of a proposed amendment shall be included in the notice of any meeting at which the proposed amendment is considered.
- (B) A resolution for the adoption of a proposed amendment may be proposed either by the Board of Directors or by not less than twenty (20%) percent of the voting interest of the Association.
- (C) Except as otherwise required by law, a proposed amendment to these Articles of Incorporation shall be adopted if it is approved by not less than two-thirds of the voting interests represented in person or by proxy at a duly noticed annual or special meeting, or by approval in writing by a majority of the total voting interests without a meeting, provided that notice of any proposed amendment has been given to the Members of the Association, and that the notice contains the text of the proposed amendment.
- (D) An amendment shall become effective upon filing with the Florida Secretary of State.
- (E) No amendment shall become effective without the written consent of the Developer for so long as the Developer is in control of the Association.

ARTICLE XIII INDEMNIFICATION OF OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

- (A) Indemnity. The Association shall indemnify any person serving as a Director, officer, or committee member to the fullest extent permitted under section 607.0850, Florida Statutes.
- (B) Additional Indemnification. The indemnification provided by this Article shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights to which those seeking indemnification may be entitled by law, agreement, vote of a majority of the voting interests of the Members or otherwise, and shall continue as to a person who has ceased to be a Director, officer, or committee member and shall inure to the benefit of the heirs and personal representatives of such person.
- (C) Insurance. The Association shall have the power to purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of any person who is or was a Director, officer, or committee member against any liability asserted against the person and incurred by the

person in any such capacity, or arising out of his or her status as such, whether or not the Association would have the power to indemnify the person against such liability under the provisions of this Article. Notwithstanding anything in this Article to the contrary, the provision herein provided for indemnification shall only be applicable to the extent insurance coverage does not apply or is insufficient.
