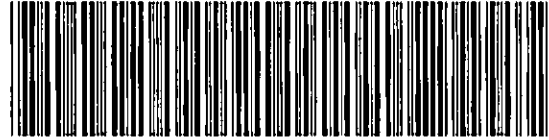

In compliance with Chapter 617 of the laws of Florida, the undersigned majority of whom are citizens of the United States, do hereby submit these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation.

### ARTICLE 1

#### *Name*

The name of the corporation is: GFWC Blountstown Woman's Club, Inc.

### ARTICLE 2

#### *Existence*

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

### ARTICLE 3

#### *Effective Date*

The effective date of incorporation shall be: upon filing by the Secretary of State.

### ARTICLE 4

#### *Type of nonprofit corporation*

The corporation is a not for profit corporation and is a public charity.



## ARTICLE 10

### *Indemnification*

The corporation does indemnify any directors, officers, employees, incorporators, and members of the corporation from any liability regarding the corporation and the affairs of the corporation, unless the person fraudulently and intentionally violated the law and/or maliciously conducted acts to damage and/or defraud the corporation, or as otherwise provided under applicable statute.

## ARTICLE 11

### *Purpose*

The purpose of the corporation is exclusively for civic, charitable, religious, educational, literary and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the internal revenue code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, and herein states of follows:

The corporation will involve its members in educational, philanthropic, social welfare, civic and cultural projects in order to enrich the individual members of the corporation and the community; and to further the progress and work of the General Federation of Women's Clubs-Florida and the General Federation of Women's Clubs. Said purpose shall be achieved through volunteer efforts on the part of the membership.

## ARTICLE 12

### *Prohibited Activities*

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 11. No substantial

part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the stated purposes of this corporation.

### ARTICLE 13

#### *Distributions Upon Dissolution*

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the legal liabilities of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
