
#### THE POTESTA FAMILY FOUNDATION, INC.

# PLAN OF DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS OF THE POTESTA FAMILY FOUNDATION, INC.

In connection with the dissolution of THE POTESTA FAMILY FOUNDATION, INC, a Florida not-for-profit corporation (the "Corporation"), located at 251 Royal Palm Way, Suite 215, Palm Beach, Florida 33480, the assets of the Corporation shall be distributed, to the extent available, in the following order and manner:

- 1. All liabilities and obligations of the Corporation shall be paid and discharged, or adequate provisions for payment and discharge shall be made.
- 2. Assets held by the Corporation upon condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance, which condition occurs by reason of the dissolution, shall be returned, transferred, or conveyed in accordance with such requirements.
- 3. Assets received and held by the Corporation subject to limitations permitting their use only for charitable, religious, electrosynary, benevolent, educational, or similar purposes, but not held upon a condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance by reason of the dissolution, shall be transferred or conveyed to one or more domestic or foreign corporations, trusts, societies, or organizations engaged in activities substantially similar to those of the Corporation as determined and approved by the Board of Directors of the Corporation.
- 4. All remaining assets, if any, shall be transferred or conveyed to one or more entities that are exempt from tax under \$501(c)(3) and \$170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or to the federal, state, or local government for exclusive public purpose, as determined and approved by the Board of Directors of the Corporation and pursuant to by the Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of the Corporation.
