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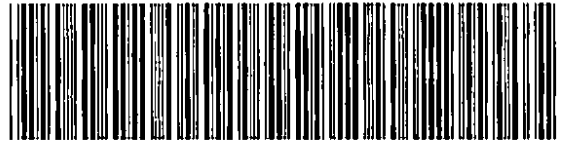

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

We, the undersigned natural persons, at least all being of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as Incorporators of a Corporation under the State of Florida Non-Profit Corporations Act (D.C. Code, Title 29, Chapter 3), do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

Article I NAME

The Corporation is a Non-Profit Corporation.

The name of this Corporation is **NOBLE ROSE VERA JEAN STYLES
SUPREME MARSHAL COUNCIL CORPORATION**

Article II DURATION

The period of duration for this Corporation shall be perpetual or until such time as the Board of Directors shall adopt a resolution recommending that the Corporation be dissolved pursuant to the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Act.

Article III PURPOSE

This Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purpose within the meaning of section 501(c)(3). The organization will engage in activities permissible under section 501(c)(3) including: promoting lasting and enduring friendships among its members and others; to foster high standards of intellectual achievement and ethical behavior among its members and others; conducting research and educating the public on issues related to health and education issues, family and economic development, and advocacy; in furtherance of and incidental thereto including assisting and supporting other organizations as may be reasonably related to the foregoing purposes, and for such non-profit purposes as may be authorized by the Florida Nonprofit Corporation and section 501(c)(3) of

the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The Corporation shall never be operated for the primary purpose of carrying on a trade or business for profit.

Notwithstanding and provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article IV AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

This Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal, by the affirmative vote of a majority of the members of its Board of Directors, any of the provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation.

Article V FUNDS AND ASSETS

This Corporation shall use its funds only to accomplish the purposes stated in these Articles of Incorporation. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to, and only to, one or more charitable organizations.

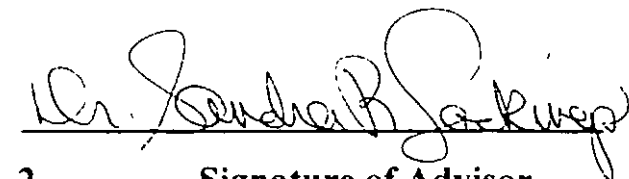
Article VI REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated for such purposes. No funds shall accrue or inure to the benefit of any individual member of the Board of Directors or other member of the organization.

The Board of Director shall have the power to adopt, amend or repeal the By-Laws of this Corporation. The By-Laws shall govern the operation of this corporation unless any By-Laws conflicts with these Articles of Incorporation shall be controlling.

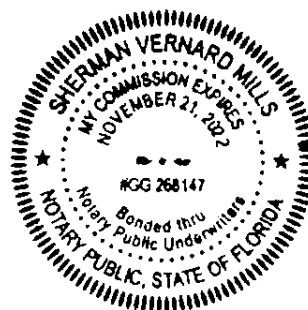
