ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

For

A Florida Non-Profit Corporation

We, the undersigned natural persons, at least all being of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as Incorporators of a Corporation under the State of Florida Non-Profit Corporations Act (D.C. Code, Title 29, Chapter 3), do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such Corporation:

Article I NAME

The Corporation is a Non-Profit Corporation.

The name of this Corporation is NOBLE ROSE VERA JEAN STYLES SUPREME MARSHAL COUNCIL CORPORATION

Article II DURATION

The period of duration for this Corporation shall be perpetual or until such time as the Board of Directors shall adopt a resolution recommending that the Corporation be dissolved pursuant to the Florida Nonprofit Corporation Act.

Article III PURPOSE

This Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purpose within the meaning of section 501(c)(3). Notwithstanding and provision of these Articles of Incorporation, this corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

Article IV AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

This Corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal, by the affirmative vote of a majority of the members of its Board of Directors, any of the provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation.

Article V FUNDS AND ASSETS

This Corporation shall use its funds only to accomplish the purposes stated in these Articles of Incorporation. Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining assets shall be distributed to, and only to, one or more charitable organizations.
