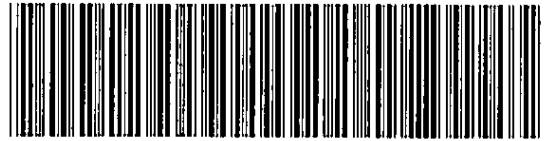

Article Three. General and Specific Purposes


