ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF KHEM TEMPLE NO. 85, DAUGHTERS OF THE NILE CORPORATION

We, the undersigned Officers, being all citizens of the state of Florida and members of Khem Temple No. 85, Daughters of the Nile, desirous of forming a corporation for charitable, philanthropic and social purposes, under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes do hereby sign and acknowledge the following articles of incorporation

ARTICLE 1 NAME

The name of this corporation shall be Khem Temple No. 85 Daughters of the Nile Corporation and its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE 11 LOCATION AND MAILING ADDRESS

The principal office and place of business of the corporation shall be at 3800 St. Johns Bluff Road South, Jacksonville, Florida 32224-2620. Mailing address is 14580 Zachary Dr. S. Jacksonville, Fl. 32218-0851

ARTICLE 111 PURPOSE

The object for which this corporation is formed, and the business or pursuit of this corporation is as follows:

ARTICLE V111 INDEBTEDNESS

The estimated value of the personal property and money possessed by this corporation at the time of making these Articles of Incorporation does not exceed the sum of Seventy-five Thousand Dollars (\$75,000) and the sources of revenue or income of this corporation shall be from dues, membership fees, gifts, donations, bequests and devises.

ARTICLE IX MEMBERS AND JURISDICTION

All members in good standing of Khem Temple No. 85 Daughters of the Nile shall be members of this corporation and they shall receive notices of stated sessions and shall have the right to vote at such sessions.

The Directors shall be entitled to rely upon the advice of legal counsel, the Accounting Firm and other experts, including financial advisors, and any act of or failure to act by the Directors in good faith reliance on such advice shall in no event subject the Directors or any such other person to liability to the Company or any Member.
