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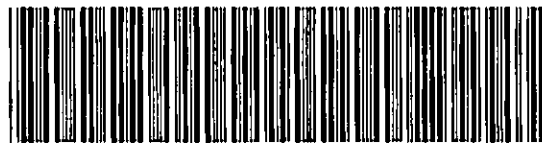

Articles of Incorporation

Article I: The name of the organizations shall be Farm Transformation Institute Inc. The period of duration is perpetual.

Article II: The principal office is located at 320 St. Johns Avenue, Suite 103, Palatka FL 32177, which also serves as the mailing address.

Article III: Farm Transformation Ince. Is a non-profit Corporation and shall operate exculsively for charitable purpose within the meaning of the Section 501c(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. The purpose is to create the framework and opportunities for an accelecrated, effective and systemic shift from industrial animal agriculture to plant-based agriculture—to increase econonmic stability for farmers, reduce negative environmental impacts and provide a humane, secure food supply.

Article IV: Election of the Board of Directors will occur once a year at the Annual Board Meeting in November of each year by a majority vote of current Board Members.

Article V: Upon termination or dissolution of Farm Transformation Institute Inc, any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501c(3) of the Internal Revenue Code which organziation(s) has a charitable purpose, which at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the purpose of Farm Transformation Institutute Inc..

Article VI: The Farm Transportation Institute Inc. corporations shall be governed by its Board of Directors—the initial Directors are as follows:

Article IX: The Registered Agent is Linda Myers, 320 St. Johns Avenue, Ste 103; Palatka, FL 32177

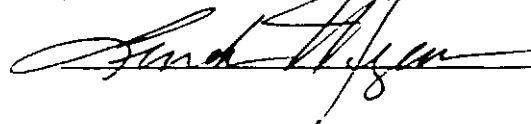
Article X: The Incorporator is Linda Myers, 320 St. Johns Avenue, Ste 103; Palatka, FL 32177
